The Law – Registration of Trade Marks

Trade Marks Act and Regulations, Cap. 13.01



Trade Mark Application

Important Elements

- Must state who the applicant/owner is
- Must contain a representation of the trade mark
- Must contain a specification of the goods and/or services associated with the trade mark for which protection is sought – must conform to the Nice Classification (established by the Nice Agreement (1957))
 - Goods/services must be accurately classed
 - Registrar to decide on disputed classification of goods etc.



What is TM Class?

- A classification database administered by the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) that incorporates the classification databases of Participating IP Offices around the world carIPI project (Eastern Caribbean)
- An Online Tool which helps users to search for and classify Goods and Services to apply for trade mark protection.
- Translate a list of Goods and Services and verify if those terms appear in the classification databases of the Participating Offices highlighted on the EUIPO's website.



ROCIP as a Participating Office

• Saint Lucia Intellectual Property Office, the Registry of Companies and Intellectual Property became a Participating Office on 25th October 2021



What does this mean?

- ROCIP database with acceptable terms of goods and services is mow included in TM Class on the EUIPO website
- You can now use TM Class to correctly search, verify, translate and classify goods before / when filing a trade mark application
