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Overview of Vietnam's GI Development

•Initial Phase (1995–2005):

- Legalization of appellations of origin.
- First protection: Phu Quoc Fish Sauce (2001).

Expansion Phase (2005–2023):

- Enactment of Intellectual Property Law (2005).
- Increase in domestic and international GI recognition.

•Consolidation Phase (Post-2023):

 Strengthened legal frameworks with amendments and new regulations.














GIs in Viet Nam by the numbers

143 Gls protected in Viet Nam through direct applications



- Domestic Gis: 130 ASEAN Gis: 5
- Other foreign Gis: 8











Case Study: Phu Quoc Fish Sauce

- History and Origins: Over 200 years of traditional production.
- . Characteristics:
 - Reddish-brown color, rich natural protein, distinctive flavor.
- Impact of GI Protection:
 - Economic: International brand, tourism boost.
 - Social: Jobs for 10,000+ workers.
 - Environmental: Sustainable anchovy harvesting.
- Challenges: Competition from industrial products.











Case Study: Hue Conical Hats



- Significance: Traditional craft tied to Hue's cultural identity.
- Characteristics: Light, thin, elegant, eco-friendly.
- Impact of GI Protection:
 - Economic: Increased commercial value and tourism.
 - Social: Jobs for women and elderly artisans.
 - Cultural: Global promotion of Hue's heritage.
 - Environmental: Encourages eco-friendly products.
- Challenges: Decline due to low consumer demand.

- Vietnam's recognition of ASEAN GIs (e.g., Isan Silk, Kampot Pepper).
- Strategic focus: Quality over quantity, sustainability, and heritage preservation.
