

Strengthening coordination of policy frameworks, regulations and practices on Intellectual Property among ASEAN Member States and the EU



Launched in April 2024, the European Union-ASEAN Sustainable Connectivity Package in Intellectual Property Rights (SCOPE IPR) aims to enhance IP protection and enforcement across ASEAN.

Building on over 30 years of EU support to ASEAN, SCOPE IPR, implemented by the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO), strengthens IP frameworks and fosters collaboration to ensure optimal protection of intellectual property across Southeast Asia.

Running until April 2028, the SCOPE IPR project will foster collaboration and align IP practices across ASEAN, helping businesses, governments, and individuals protect their intellectual property in an increasingly interconnected world. By promoting harmonisation and cooperation among ASEAN Member States, SCOPE IPR aims to create favourable conditions for trade, investment, and innovation, with a focus on robust IP protection.

Provide technical assistance to improve legal and regulatory IP frameworks, enabling ASEAN Member States to participate more fully in global IP protection systems.



Support the development of ASEAN IPR policy frameworks, including the ASEAN IPR Action Plan and regional platforms.



Organise networking and capacity-building activities to enhance the capacity of ASEAN Intellectual Property Offices to deliver timely, quality services.



Deliver capacity building for the private sector and raise targeted awareness on IP among key stakeholders and the general public.
