I. History of GI in Cambodia

- ❖MoC Developing Geographical Indication since 2007 as following:
 - Geographical Indications (GI) System including: Establishing the Geographical Indication Office
 - Legal framework and implementing the pilot project to register "Kampot pepper" and "Kampong Speu palm sugar" which is a unique products in relation to the geographical area, knowledge, know-how, culture of the local people, and has a well-known reputation as a geographical indication.
- GI is an IP tool that plays an important role in promoting entrepreneurship, developing agricultural communities, increasing community income, creating competitiveness in trade, which contributes to social, economic, cultural and tourism development in Cambodia.
- ❖GI Products provide a value added in terms of economic, social, environment, cultural and tourism for Cambodia, but there is a need to develop a strong GI system, which must be indispensable from the relevant ministries, institutions and development partners to ensure the sustainability of GI and promoting the listing of more potential products as GI.

II. Law and regulations related to GI in Cambodia

- Prakas on the Establishment and Use of National Symbols for Geographical Indications, dated 16 August 2010
- ❖ Law on Geographical Indication was promulgated on January 20, 2014.
- Prakas on the Procedure for Registration and Protection of Geographical Marks No. 422, dated December 29, 2016
- WTO Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property (TRIPS) Cambodia became a member of the Geneva Law on the Lisbon Agreement on the Origin of Goods and Geographical Indication on March 9, 2018
- Cambodia became a member of the Geneva Act of the Lisbon Agreement on Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications on March 9, 2018

Abstract:

A detoxifying composition for oral administration, characterised in that it comprises dried inflorescence stems from the pepper plant, that are optionally ground and optionally sieved, and/or a liquid or dry extract of pepper plant inflorescence stems.

The pepper plant inflorescence stems are advantageously chosen from inflorescence stems from the Piper nigrum or Piper longum

pepper plants, in particular from the Kampot region of Cambodia. The food composition or supplement or fortified foodstuff or dietary product containing same is used in order to promote the elimination of waste from the organism, in particular by the liver.



Mondulkiri Wild Honey – A Geographical Indication from Cambodia

Geographical Indication Protects Giant Honey Bees and Expected to Raise Living Standards for the Priong

The Apis dorsata bee is a giant honeybee with little patience for interference and aggressive defense strategies but for centuries, in the northeastern thickly forested mountains areas of Cambodia, the Pnong ethnic group has mastered honey-harvesting skills. The wild honey from Mondulkiri, well known by Cambodian consumers, is now protected by a geographical indication, bringing hopes for increased revenue for harvesters, and heightened protection of wild bee colonies and the forest.


