Ensure product quality.


Preserve and promote the value of tangible and intangible heritage, as well as the biodiversity of Vietnam.

Consumers can identify specialty products.


Share and support rural tourism and craft village tourism in local areas.

STATUS OF GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS IN VIETNAM

143 GIS PROTECTED IN VIET NAM THROUGH DIRECT APPLICATIONS



Mainly fruit products, accounting for 35% of the total number of protected geographical indications; aquatic products 14%; medicinal herbs 10%; products from industrial crops 10%; rice 9%











ACTS OF INFRINGEMENT OF RIGHTS TO GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS

• According to Point c, Clause 3, Article 129 of the Intellectual Property Law 2005, as amended in 2022:

The following acts are considered infringements of protected geographical indication rights: Using any sign identical or similar to a protected geographical indication for products not originating from the geographical area indicated, causing consumers to mistakenly believe that the products originate from that geographical area

ENFORCING GI RIGHTS IN VIETNAM

Civil remedies

- Compelling the termination of infringing acts
- Compelling the public apology and rectification
- Compelling the performance of civil obligations
- Compelling the payment of damages
- Compelling destruction, distribution or use for noncommercial purposes of goods

Adminstrative remedies

- Confiscation of intellectual property counterfeit goods, suspension of business activities
- Compelled destruction or distribution or use for non-commercial purposes of intellectual property counterfeit goods

Temporary custody of persons/goods

Criminal remedies

- Imprisonment
- Fine

Border measures

- Suspension of customs clearance
- Inspection and supervision
- Ex Officio Action

CHALLENGES AND DIFFICULTIES IN GI PROTECTION IN VIETNAM

Limited awareness among producers and consumers

Inconsistent product quality and loose management

Lack of geographical indications for processed products, not commensurate with potential

Weak law enforcement capacity

Difficulties in expanding geographical indications to international markets

SOLUTIONS TO ENHANCE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF GI PROTECTION IN VIETNAM

Continue to improve the legal framework for geographical indications (Gls), remove barriers, and create a more open legal environment to strengthen GI protection

activities;

Standardize the management and control model for Gls (at three levels: self-management, internal management, and external management);

Enhance coordination between state management agencies and between these

agencies and business

entities;

Increase activities to raise public awareness of intellectual property (IP), and strengthen information dissemination about IP; Promote international cooperation and experience sharing to advance the protection of Vietnamese geographical indications abroad.

CONCLUSION

Geographical indications are an essential tool for local economic development, ensuring the value and reputation of region-specific products.

Effective protection and enforcement of geographical indications require coordinated efforts, a comprehensive legal framework, and increased community awareness.

All stakeholders are encouraged to participate in developing and preserving local heritage through geographical indications.
