- Specialized agency of the United Nations
- 193 Member States
- Secretariat based in Geneva, Switzerland
- Over 1,300 employees from more than 110 countries
- Not for profit
- Self-funded through fee-paying services
- Seven external offices including Singapore


Protection Options

...Then a choice must be made regarding the best way to protect your trademark/s abroad:

- The national route file trademark application/s with the IP Office of each country in which you want protection
- The international route file through the Madrid System




The Madrid System is Global

- 124 countries covered
- These members represent more than 80% of world trade
- Recent accessions include:
 - **2017**: Thailand, Indonesia
 - 2018: Afghanistan, Malawi, Samoa
 - 2019: Brazil, Canada, Malaysia
- All ASEAN countries except Myanmar



When to Use Madrid?

If you have limited budget and time to spend on registration and management of your trademarks



The Madrid System is Cost-Effective

File an international application, which is the same as a bundle of national applications, effectively saving you time and money.



The Madrid System is Cost-Effective

Avoid paying for translations into multiple languages or working through the administrative procedures of multiple IP Offices





Fee Calculator

Use the Fee Calculator to estimate the cost for:

- Subsequent designations
- Renewals
- Fees based on the Contracting Parties and number of classes you select, according to the current <u>Schedule of Fees</u>
- Applicable fee reduction for applicants from <u>Least</u>
 <u>Developed Countries (LDCs)</u>

Individual entrepreneurs, small and large businesses find the Madrid System to be a convenient and cost-effective means to protect marks in key markets throughout the world






