AL-INVEST Verde IPR

Innovation and the diffusion of new technologies are indispensable for economic growth. They lead to higher productivity and the creation of wealth and economic welfare, including decent jobs and greener economies.

The EU-funded Action AL-INVEST Verde IPR Action proposes to use intellectual property to contribute to the development of an enabling framework in Latin America, with emphasis on MERCOSUR countries, to stimulate innovation and facilitate sustainable growth, job creation and ensure effective international participation of their economic actors.

Objective and description of the event

The objective of this activity is to highlight the socio-economic importance of intellectual property rights for innovation and economic development on the basis of studies carried out in the EU and in countries of the region.
