
BSJ: Control Body: Role

- Assist producers to develop their Code of Practice for Gls to ensure consistency and product quality. This should include the appropriate action to be taken if the producer is not adhering to the code of practice.
- Certification and auditing of GI certified products through an accredited body (Certification or denial of the use of the GI).

BSJ: Control Body: Role

Writing specifications: a necessary sorting

Census of all on what the product « means »



Subjective elements

Minor elements with no added value


Uncontrollable elements

Economic feasibility



Product Specification credible and economically viable






- ➤ Develop an inspection methodology to ensure that individual producers are adhering to the code of practice.
- ➤ This would include testing for pre-determined product characteristics at different points in the production process where appropriate, and recommending improvements or penalties as required by the code of practice.

BSJ: Control Body: Role

LINKS BETWEEN SPECIFICATIONS AND CONTROL PLAN

- Specification writing shall be specific, concrete and pragmatic
- Specifications shall not contain subjective elements
 - each statement may become a "checkpoint"
- It should allow a clear identification of control points and:
 - Control methods
 - Control frequencies

BSJ: Control Body: Role

Have at least one person trained and skilled in administering the programme.

Monitor and evaluate the national GI development agenda to predict service demand.

GI CERTIFICATION

 Certificates are issued by the certification/control body for compliant products on the basis of audit results and, if any, test results

Adequacy between the product and its market(s)




Producers group must lead the development of the control system

STANDARDS DEVELOPMENT PROCESS





Definition of a Standard

Technical Meaning

A document approved by a recognized body, that provides for common and repeated use, rules, guidelines or characteristics for products or related processes and production methods with which compliance is not mandatory.

Simple Meaning

An accepted way of doing something.


