SEMINAR: The governance of geographical indications (GIs) for artisan products in Brazil - Origens Brasileira Artesanato.

Jointly organised by SEBRAE (Brazilian Micro and Small Business Support Service) and INPI BR (Brazilian IP Office), with the collaboration of INPI France. It aimed to raise awareness on how GIs could contribute to the protection of the authenticity, quality, and cultural identity of artisanal products. It also aimed to share best practices and experiences from the EU and Latin America in the development and marketing of artisanal products with GIs.
