On 20 June, CarIPI will collaborate with the IP Office of Dominica (CIPO) to host an online session on Geographical Indications with relevant stakeholders in the country.

The objective of this session will be to present the <u>GI model law</u> and the <u>GI manual</u>, developed by the project to serve as a guide for producer groups, Control Bodies, and CF IP offices on the process of developing and implementing codes of practice and controls, and registering a Geographical Indication.

Furthermore, the team will share information on the assistance the project can provide to producers of origin-linked-products through its Mentorship Programme. With the objective of enhancing the competitiveness of unique products (agricultural and non-agricultural) from the region, the Programme provides technical assistance in developing business strategies based on IP rights.
