#### RELEVANT EPAARTICLE

#### ART. 149 PLANT VARIETIES

The EC Party and the Signatory CARIFORUM States shall provide for the protection of plant varieties in accordance with the TRIPS Agreement. In this respect, they shall consider acceding to the International Convention for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants — UPOV (Act of 1991).

#### **Technical Assistance to DO - 2020**

CarlPI:

CarlPI provided technical assistance to Dom Rep, resulting in a fully functional and UPOV compliant PV framework and office, with trained staff and DUS examiners.

The Dominican Republic is now leader in plant protection and innovation in the region

CarlPI provided support to:

- Set-up procedures,
- Develop examination manual, forms and templates
  - Train examiners

#### Technical Assistance to Saint Vincent and the Grenadines

### Effective plant variety registrations Framework for SVG

- Following Saint Vincent and the Grenadines UPOV accession in 2021
- Technical assistance was provided to develop the national system to administer plant breeders' rights
- TA included drafting of implementing regulations to national legislation
- Development of PVR examination guidelines and forms in compliance with international / UPOV standards
- 8-9 November training of staff and examiners of plant varieties



# COTED Agricultural Ministers – Policy Paper

#### In collaboration with CPVO, UPOV, CARICOM

- Policy Paper: Proposal for enhancing regional Cooperation on PVRs
- Survey on the policy paper sent to CS for feedback 10 countries responded
- A proposal was put forward to the Ministers of Agriculture at their meetings in the framework of the CWA 2021

# Regional Cooperation in PVRs



- Policy Paper on Regional Cooperation in Plant Variety Protection was prepared with CPVO, UPOV and circulated to CS member states
  - Plant Breeding and PVRs as instruments for economic development
  - Reviving the plant breeding sector in the region, supported by an efficient system of Plant Variety Rights,
  - Facilitate
    - internal trade among CFS, but would also
    - enhance trade possibilities, especially with the EU, which remains the main destination for exports from the region in agricultural goods.
    - benefits breeders, farmers and the society at large.

# Regional Cooperation in PVRs



Policy Paper on Regional Cooperation in Plant Variety Protection was prepared with CPVO, UPOV and circulated to CS member states

- IT System for PVR registration at regional level
- Feasibility of establishing an IT System to manage the registration of national titles through a Regional hub ("one-stop shop")
- UPOV PRISMA, which is an on-line tool to assist in filing plant variety protection IT package
- The e-PVP platform provides the basis for regional cooperation in line with the UPOV Convention, including:
  - a single application form;
  - mutual acceptance of the DUS Test results and administrative proceedings;
  - Preliminary examination of novelty and denominations

# Regional Cooperation in PVRs: COTED



A proposal has been put forward by CARICOM and in cooperation with UPOV & CPVO, to the Ministers of Agriculture at their meetings in the framework of the Caribbean Week of Agriculture 2021, to endorse Plant Variety Protection in their territories and consider joining UPOV.

The COTED officials meeting accepted the proposal and this was presented at the Ministerial Meeting on 8 Oct 2021
