
Mediation working methodology

- a. Identifying issues and common ground
- b. Formulating offers and bargaining
- a. Concluding the mediation process



The phases of mediation

5 phases





Identifying issues and common ground

- Initial joint session, opening statements → list of issues
- Individual private sessions (caucuses)
- Building trust
- Emotions
- Fact-finding (open questions)





Identifying issues and common ground

- Needs and interests versus positions
- Legal versus **business**
- Moving the parties from the past to the **future**







Formulating offers and bargaining

Bargaining / negotiation / offers phase

- Individual private sessions / possible intermittent joint sessions
- Importance of **confidentiality**
- Avoiding relay of 'insult offers'





Formulating offers and bargaining

- Reality testing and evaluative mediation techniques
- Reformulating
- Facilitative mediation techniques



- ✓ **BATNA**: Best Alternative to a Negotiated Agreement
- ✓ WATNA: Worst Alternative to a Negotiated Agreement
- ✓ **ZOPLA**: Zone of Possible Agreement



Where settlement is reached

- Drafting settlement agreement
- It is the lawyers' responsibility



• The mediator shall not be liable for the legality and enforceability of the settlement agreement.



Finalising detailed settlement terms

- Applicable law / competent jurisdictions
- Ensure that the agreement satisfies the parties and is workable



- Clear and comprehensive record of what has been agreed
- Clarify follow-up actions



Where settlement is not reached

- progress achieved
- outstanding matters
- next steps







Formal steps at the EUIPO post-mediation

- Send out satisfaction questionnaire
- Destruction of all documentation

- Parties' formal request of termination of proceedings
- Notification of decision closing proceedings
