# What is a Geographical Indication?

- A sign identifying a product as originating from a specific place
- Quality, reputation or characteristics linked to geographic origin
- Recognized form of intellectual property
- Protects authenticity and consumer trust

# Why GI Protection for Saint Lucia Rum

- GI protection ensures “Saint Lucia Rum” is used only for authentic products.
- Unique environmental conditions and distillation practices contribute to distinct character.
- Supports export opportunities and branding
- Encourages preservation of traditional production methods
- Promotes tourism and national identity

# Role of Saint Lucia Distillers

- Developed the GI product specification and production methods
- Defined production standards and geographic area
- Submitted application to ROCIP
- Ensured quality control

# Role of ROCIP

- Administers the Geographical Indications Act
- Received and examined GI application for Saint Lucia Rum.
- Provided guidance to ensure application clearly linked product to origin.

# Examination Process

- Conducted formal and substantive examination
- Assessed legal compliance, name originality, and potential conflicts.
- Ensured the GI is well-defined and protectable.
- Upon acceptance application published in official gazette.
- Formally registered after opposition period elapses.

# Reflections from the Intellectual Property Office

- Early engagement with producers is essential
- Clear product specifications facilitate examination
- Capacity building strengthens implementation
- Collaboration improves long-term sustainability

# Challenges Encountered

- Coordinating multiple stakeholders
- Documenting traditional knowledge
- Building awareness of GI systems
- Ensuring long-term compliance mechanisms

# Lessons Learned

- Strong cooperation between IPO and producers is vital
- Clear governance structures support GI management
- Education and outreach improve understanding
- GI protection strengthens national branding

# Future Opportunities

- Expand GI protection to other Saint Lucian products such as cocoa and pottery.
- Strengthen international promotion of Saint Lucia Rum
- Develop certification and monitoring systems
- Enhance collaboration between producers and regulators
